WHAT: A rally to protest 100 job cuts at The Sun

WHEN: Thursday, July 17 at Noon sharp

WHERE: In front of The Sun building at 501 N. Calvert Street

WHY: Because The Sun has been the main source of news for Baltimore and Maryland for nearly two centuries, and the deep cuts the company is making in both staff and news pages will mean less coverage of this community, less accountability for public officials, and less knowledge of the world around us.

Because many of the people leaving us are talented, experienced newsmen and newswomen who have dedicated their lives to holding people and institutions accountable, and their departure dims the "light for all" we have long promised our readers. Beyond that, the community of people who support those of us who write and produce the news -- those who sell ads, take subscription calls and keep the building running -- are all feeling this pain.

And because these are the darkest days yet for this newspaper we have long loved, but we have likely not seen how dark it can get. We need to let the community and our bosses know how much these cuts hurt us, our livelihoods and the community that depends on us.
